AIMS & OBJECTIVES

Eco Challenge is an online game learning programme (developed by [UNEP-DHI Center](#)) which aims to raise awareness of the importance and challenges of managing limited water resources in the face of rapid economic development worldwide. - learn to be responsible global citizens

PROGRAMME FRAMEOWRK

It is divided into HK session & International session.

- HK students receive training before the competition
- Two rounds of competition in HK
- Top 6 HK teams are eligible to join the summer camp & international competition in Korea

** Winning teams have to pay for the costs of visiting Korea
