UNSW is implementing a procedure to assess applicants who are completing the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) in 2016, for mid year entry in 2016 into the:

- Bachelor of Aviation (Flying), UNSW program 3980
- Bachelor of Aviation (Management), UNSW program 3981

HKDSE students can apply on the basis of their mock DSE exam results, and if they achieve the academic requirements they will be made a full offer, with conditions. The offer will need to be accepted within the timeframe specified in the letter of offer. [The conditions will require the students to meet academic requirements as listed below, including English].

The offer will allow students to:

- Make bookings in UNSW student housing
- Make travel plans to arrive in Sydney and begin at start of Second Semester (25th July 2016)
- Confirm with the School any questions they may have regarding program arrangements (including additional costs for flying training for program 3980 which will begin intensively the following January)
- Once the offer is accepted, make application for a student visa

On verification of the actual DSE results achieving the minimum entry requirements, students will be able to immediately implement their plans.

To make application, go to: apply.unsw.edu.au, or contact your local education agent.

Those applicants that do not meet the 17 point criterion may enter the UNSW Foundation Studies Transition Program (15 or 16 Points) or Standard Program (11 points or more).

Entry Requirements are as follows:

- Entry requirements are based on the total points achieved from the best 5 Category A subjects. Mathematics is counted as one subject regardless of whether Extension is taken. Category B and C subjects are not counted. Grades for all subjects except Mathematics are counted as follows: Level 5** and Level 5*=6, Level 5=5, Level 4=4, Level 3=3, Level 2=2 and Level 1=1. Grades for Compulsory Mathematics are counted as follows: Level 5** and Level 5*=3, Level 5=2.5, Level 4=2, Level 3=1.5, Level 2=1 and Level 1=0.5. Grades for Extension Mathematics are counted as follows: Level 5** and Level 5*=4, Level 5=3.5, Level 4=3, Level 3=2.5, Level 2=2 and Level 1=1.5.
- English language requirement: a minimum of **4** in **English language**, or alternative satisfactory English test results.
