**1 Theme of the Year**

“Engage Community, Build a Better Living Environment”

**2 Topic**

“Add to improve an existing space in Hong Kong, for the long-term growth to the surrounding area of the identified space.”

**3 Objectives**

- 3.1 To introduce / practice spatial design as the creative relating of spaces.
- 3.2 To make a space where general public can enjoy their daily life in long term.
- 3.3 To practice precise working methods and presentation.

**4 Proposed Action Plan**

4.1 Find a space, anywhere in Hong Kong, your team thinks it has potential to be turned into a better space, as in terms of:

- 4.1.1 Permeability (is it easy to access?)
- 4.1.2 Aesthetic (does it look good?)
- 4.1.3 Ventilation (does it smell good?)
- 4.1.4 Lighting (is it easy to see things...)
- 4.1.5 Spaciousness (size of the space...)

*It is advised to split into two teams in research:*

*Team A - find out all basic information about the space (i.e. location / google map, landmarks around, size, how did you get there, etc.)*

*Team B – visit the space again, gather on site information for your design (i.e. take photos, etc.)*

4.2 Explain why your team chooses this space.

4.3 Improve the chosen space. How so? You may consider the following methods:

- 4.3.1 Observe / interview the existing users of the space
- 4.3.2 Feel and experience the space yourselves

Based on your findings above, propose to add something, anything, to make it better. **That something could be a thing like a seating bench, a directional sign, a recycle bin, a pergola, etc.**

4.4 Record the status of the chosen space before & after at your team’s proposed improvement. Draw your design using Photoshop or hand sketches to provide an imaginative graphic for presentation purpose.

4.5 Design a poster and prepare the Powerpoint for your presentation of your proposed improvement to the space in terms of the following ‘selling points’:

- 4.5.1 Environmental Improvements
- 4.5.2 Economical Improvements
- 4.5.3 Cultural Improvements
- 4.5.4 Improvement to Local Community Life

**5 Deliverables**

5.1 Written Group Project Report (40%)
